### Build your future with skills in infrastructure

Gain the skills to prepare for a career in infrastructure projects, and pick up your White Card along the way!

You will learn the knowledge and skills to work safely in the civil construction industry, communicate effectively on work sites and plan work in relation to infrastructure activities.

This introduction is suitable for students who wish to enter the industry with no or limited experience.

Gain the skills to:

- Follow work health and safety policies and procedures
- Plan and organise work
- Carry out measurements and calculations
- Communicate effectively in the work place
- Operate small plant and equipment

Students also have the opportunity to undertake a work placement with an employer that is arranged by South Metropolitan TAFE.

### Next course dates:

Students attend classes at Thornlie campus four days a week (Monday-Thursday) for the first three weeks. Week four

consists of a work placement for five days.
