About this course

If you are interested in a career in Cyber Security, CompTIA Security + is one of the first Vendor Certifications you should aim for to get started in your security career. Globally recognised, CompTIA will provide you with the skills you need to get your first job in Cyber Security.

Gain these skills:

- Detect various types of compromises and understand penetration testing and vulnerability scanning concepts
- Install, configure, and deploy network components while assessing and troubleshooting issues to support organisational security
- Implement secure network architecture concepts and systems design
- Install and configure identity and access services, as well as management controls
- Implement and summarise risk management best practices and the business impact
- Install and configure wireless security settings and implement public key infrastructure

To be able to complete this course you will need knowledge of networking to the level of Cisco CCENT, CompTIA Network + or equivalent courses in Information Technology or Networking at Certificate IV level or higher.

Once completing the CompTIA Security+ course, you will be able to sit the exam and become Vendor Certified when you successfully pass.
