Advance your employability skills and build your treatment menu with our upcoming Skin Needling Workshops. Skin needling is a growing treatment within salons and dermal clinics due to its visible results.

Skin Needling, also referred to as; Percutaneous Collagen Induction (PCI), Collagen Induction Therapy (CIT), Dermal Rolling or Dermal Stamping all involve creating a microscopic pin-prick wound with a needle device creating tiny channels into the epidermis engaging the body's natural wound healing response. Skin Needling is a procedure for the reduction of wrinkles, thin skin density, hyper-pigmentation, photo ageing, scars, and stretch marks.

Skin Needling leaves the epidermis intact without damage to the stratum corneum. It promotes wound healing while encouraging an even deposition of collagen and elastin.

This course is essential for anyone wishing to perform Skin Needling and advance their aesthetic skin treatment knowledge.

This course will cover:

- The Wound Healing Process
- Skin Needling Depths and Different Interactions
- Treatment Indications and contra-indications
- Consultation process

- Treatment Parameters and Protocols

Students will receive a Certificate of Attendance on completion.
