Training is delivered through full-time, part-time or online combinations—at your place or ours. Qualifications include certificates I-IV, diploma and advanced diploma. Micro qualifications focusing on specific skill sets can also be undertaken, ranging from foundation numeracy and literacy to singular trade and course units.

AUSPICE ARRANGEMENT

SM TAFE and the institutional client or partner may enter into a third party agreement under which the partner's students are eligible to gain a qualification issued by SM TAFE. Under this type of arrangement, students are enrolled with both the institutional client or partner college(s) and SM TAFE.

The training and assessment for a qualification can be facilitated by qualified trainers engaged by the third party ('partner'). Students are enrolled with SM TAFE and issue the final award and/or statement of attainment ensuring that the training and assessment strategies align to the Standards for Registered Training Organisations 2015.

SM TAFE works with the partner to address any gaps and provides teacher training, curriculum development and advice on resources and facilities where required.

EMBEDDED PARTNERSHIP ARRANGEMENT

SM TAFE's embedded model sees partner employees working collaboratively with SM TAFE staff at one of our industry specialised campuses. This encompasses three primary elements ensuring teaching staff of the institutional client:

- undergo a structured program of training and assessment within SM TAFE to receive a vocational teaching qualification or skill set as required
- to have access to SM TAFE technical staff and resources through observing the application of competency learning and assessment
- be exposed to Australian teaching culture, language and society through interaction with SM TAFE's teaching staff and students.

This experience provides the opportunity for partner staff to be exposed to SM TAFE's expert knowledge and competency based training while accessing technical and staff resources. The employee can then return and share this knowledge with their own staff.




COMPETING ON THE WORLD STAGE
