Please read the following information regarding your Fee Notice for course fees at South Metropolitan TAFE.

The fee notice is provided to you in accordance with federal legislation, and meets requirements prescribed by the VET Student Rules 2016.

A Fee Notice is provided to all students in approved courses who <u>may</u> be eligible to apply for a VET Student Loan, subject to the student meeting individual eligibility requirements.

If you have not applied for a VET Student Loan, and do not wish to apply for a loan, you may disregard the Notice.

You will notice the Total VET Student Loan Debt is \$0.00 – This means that you have not elected to access a VET Student Loan, and none of your current course fees can or will be deferred to a loan. If your Loan Debt is showing an amount above \$0.00 and you believe this is incorrect, please contact the VET Student Loans Office immediately for correction.

You may apply for a VET Student Loan at any time during your course, however this must be completed and approved 14 days prior to the earliest Census Date for your course if you wish to have your whole course placed on a loan. Units cannot be retrospectively placed on a loan if you apply after any Census Dates. Any units with census dates passing prior to your loan application being approved must be paid for direct to South Metropolitan TAFE.

If you apply for a VET Student Loan after receiving this Fee Notice, you will be re-issued with an updated Fee Notice, which will show which units can be placed on your loan.
