## Study area information for apprentices

### Dress requirements / PPE

- Safety steel-capped work boots must be worn during engineering classes.
  - Heavy leather uppers and heavy duty soles.
  - No sand shoe volley type of footwear allowed (even with steel caps)
  - Fully closed in shoes for all non-engineering classes
- Overalls during engineering classes
- Water, food, hat and sunscreen for boat days

### Stationery

- Notebooks
- Pencils
- Pens
- Folder for notebooks and handouts

### Licences

- Additional external fees to be paid for issuance of Radio certificate at time of assessment
- Additional fees payable to AMSA for issuance of Certificate of Safety Training (COST) card
- Must complete HLTAID003 Provide First Aid prior to completion of course, not delivered internally/as part of course
