Dress requirements / PPE

- Protective eye wear
 - Clear safety glasses to be worn at all times in the workshop
 - Tinted safety glasses permitted when working outside only
 - o All safety glasses must meet Australian Safety Standards
- Enclosed footwear to be worn at all times
 - Workshop activities footwear must include toe protection (steel or composite) that meets Australian Safety Standards
 - o Classroom activities strictly no slides, thongs or Croc type footwear, feet must be enclosed at all times
- 100% cotton protective workwear clothing
 - Long sleeve shirts and long pants when welding
