

Hospitality Students - Uniform Requirements

All hospitality students are required to participate in practical training sessions, either at the **Saltbush Training Restaurant**, located at the Mandurah Campus or at **Bentley Pines**, located at the Bentley Campus. To maintain a professional standard and ensure safety during these sessions, full uniform is mandatory for all practical training, including barista or restaurant classes.

Uniform Components:

- Black Tailored Pants
- White Long Sleeve Collared Shirt
- Black Business Socks
- Black Enclosed Shoes
- Apron (\$30.00 available for purchase on campus only)

Preparation: Students are advised to organise their uniform prior to the start of the semester. This preparation is crucial for participation in practical training sessions from day one.

BLACK TAILORED PANTS



**PLEASE NOTE – Black pants <u>MUST</u> be tailored business black pants, they cannot be jeans, chinos, leggings or any other types of pants.

WHITE LONG SLEEVE COLLARED SHIRT



** **PLEASE NOTE** – Needs to be a long sleeve plain business shirt with no logos or other designs.



BLACK BUSINESS SOCKS



****PLEASE NOTE** – Needs to be plain black business socks. No logos, no ankle socks

BLACK LEATHER ENCLOSED SHOES



** **PLEASE NOTE** – Need to be enclosed, non-slip, flat sole shoes that can be polished. No sneaker or jogger style shoes will be permitted due to WHS requirements

<u>APRON</u>



**PLEASE NOTE – Saltbush or Bentley Pines apron to be purchased from the Hospitality area at SMTAFE Mandurah or Bentley Campus. This can be purchased at the commencement of your studies.

The cost of the apron will be \$30.00, subject to supplier

Please note the apron, like the remainder of your uniform must be clean and ironed before each practical service.
